and, thus, lost directional control of the aircraft. The aircraft veered off to the left of RWY 01 and, subsequently, ground-looped and impacted the ground with the right wingtip first, followed by the nose. The aircraft sustained substantial damage. The pilot was not injured during the accident sequence. The pilot reported that there were no pre-accident mechanical failures or malfunctions that would have precluded normal operations.

# Probable cause:

The pilot touched down hard and lost directional control, which resulted in the aircraft ground looping and impacting the ground with the right-side wing.
