**NOTIFICATION OF GUIDANCE INFORMATION PUBLISHED ON THE WEBSITE FOR DEVELOPMENTS
AROUND AERODROMES**

Purpose

The purpose of this AIC is to advise and communicate to obstacle applicants and developers in South Africa to utilise the guidance information as published on the South African Civil Aviation (SACAA) website, on the obstacles page towards developments around Aerodromes.

Background

Civil Aviation Regulation Part 139.01.30 refers: "A person or authority involved in land development, shall not compromise air safety by authorising or developing any land or erecting buildings or obstacles on such land." For ease of reference, the SACAA has published guidance information for developments around aerodromes which include the marking conditions such as Night or Night and Day markings of obstacles and the aviation requirements which must be considered when conducting land use, planning and approval of structures anywhere in the Republic.

Notification to all Obstacle Applicants/Developers

Note that the SACAA has provided guidance information to the industry for obstacle control of developments around aerodromes.
