**LEARNING OBJECTIVES FOR INSTRUMENT RATING OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES (IR OPS)
EXAMINATION/S FOR AEROPLANE (H) AND HELICOPTER (H) PILOTS**

The purpose of this AIC is to assist students, Aviation Training Organisations (ATOs), prospective examination candidates and the civil aviation industry in identifying important Learning Objectives (LO) in the existing syllabus that must be achieved in order to prepare for the respective SACAA Pilot examinations.


The Examinations section in their quest to further assist students in line with the existing Curriculum and Syllabus for the respective subjects and categories, shall publish Learning Objectives. The learning objectives will further assist students to prepare for exams and ultimately improve knowledge and ultimately their final mark.

As required by International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), the SACAA has the responsibility to constantly update its examinations database in line with the published curriculum and syllabus. The SACAA has over the years updated their exams database to ensure compliance with recommendations by ICAO.

The addition of Learning Objectives does not change the Curriculum nor the syllabus but provide guidance to the students in order to assist them during examinations.

Furthermore, the introduction of Learning Objectives to further assist students without either adding to or reducing the scope and extent of academic studies or the approved and recommended study materials or other sources of reference, some of which are contained in the SA-CARS, SA-CATS, AIPs and other relevant legislation.

The Examination Learning Objectives will be added/published on the SACAA website and shared with the ATOs.
