**1. Background**

- 1.1 In accordance with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) the Aeronautical Information Service (AIS) is responsible to provide pilots, air crew, operators and air traffic services with timely and accurate information essential for the safety, regularity and efficiency of air navigation.
- 1.2 In order to comply with the aforementioned, Air Traffic and Navigation Services company (ATNS) introduced a Post-Flight information reporting system on the 15<sup>th</sup> of July 1999.

**2. Purpose**

- 2.1 The purpose of the Post-Flight information system is to ensure that any inadequacies or hazards, observed by pilots and operators in the course of their operations, relating to ATS procedures, services and facilities essential to the safety and or efficiency of air navigation are reported to the authority or service providers responsible.

**3. Procedure for the collection of Post-Flight information**

- 3.1 Pilots, air crew and operators intending to participate in the provision of Post-Flight information, are to complete the Post-Flight reporting form and submit this to the ATNS Aeronautical Information Management (AIM). The Post-Flight reporting form can be submitted via the following media:
