MILITARY AIRSPACES AND AERODROMES

LANDINGS AT UNCONTROLLED MILITARY AERODROMES

- Indicates changes
- This AIC replaces AIC 27.1 dated 02-03-15.
- 1. The Defence Act 44 of 1957 states that no Civilian aircraft may land at a military aerodrome without prior permission being obtained from: - The Chief of the Air Force, S.A. Air Force Headquarters

- 2. The Defence Force has established various landing strips which are uncontrolled and civilian aircraft often land at these aerodromes without obtaining prior permission.
- 3. It must be pointed out, however, that even with prior permission, persons using such aerodromes do so at their own risk and the Defence Act also states that the Department of Defence shall not be liable to any person who makes use of any property of the Department or for loss or damage resulting from damage to property caused by or arising out of the said defence service or property.
