GENERAL

CONTROL OF KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

According to Section 47 of the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act (NEMPA), the following is stated: "the airspace above a Proclaimed National Park is 2,500 feet above the highest point, within the boundaries of the National Park."

In the case of the Kruger National Park (KNP), the highest point within its boundaries is a mountain called, Kandizwe located at co-ordinates S25.472259 and E031.425162. The elevation of Kandizwe is 2,753 feet above mean sea level, which puts the restricted airspace in the KNP at a minimum of 5,253 feet above mean sea level.

All flights into and out of this airspace require prior authorisation from South African National Parks (SANParks) as the Management Authority.

There is also a shared Military restricted airspace (FAR 78) covering most of the KNP. This restricted airspace is from ground to 10,500 feet. All flights in this airspace require prior authorisation from the controlling body - Air Traffic Controller, Executive Lowveld Airspace Control Sector, as well.
