

**CAUTIONARY NOTICE REGARDING APPROPRIATE VHF REPORTING/BROADCAST ACTION
FAPZ (PROGRESS) (S335530 E0252220) FREQ 122.7 MHz**

- ☛ Indicates changes
- ☛ This AIC replaces AIC 008/2014 dated 30 APR 2014.
- ☛ All pilots are instructed to take note of the requirements to report on the dedicated Progress (FAPZ) FREQ 122.7 MHz when entering the FAPZ area and/or operating within 5NM of FAPZ (as per South African AIP ENR 2.2) excluding the FAPE CTR and FAD 193.

Pilots should make the appropriate broadcast on the FAPZ FREQ 122.7 MHz when entering the FAPZ area and take all necessary collision avoidance action prior to entering or leaving the FAPZ area. Traffic routing from FAPE to FAPZ should report on FAPZ FREQ 122.77 MHz passing Greenbushes mast (S335610.32 E0252627.96).
