GENERAL

LEGISLATION MATTERS

APPLICABILITY OF LEGISLATION ADMINISTERED BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY TO THE AVIATION INDUSTRY

1. *The South African Civil Aviation Authority Act, 1998 (Act No 40 of 1998), (the SACAA Act"), establishes the South African Civil Aviation Authority ("the Authority"), as an entity and governs its activities.*
2. *In terms of section 4(2) of the SACAA Act, read together with Schedule I to the Act, the Authority is responsible for the administration of the Aviation Act, 1962, (Act No 74 of 1962), ("the Aviation Act"), the Civil Aviation Offences Act, 1972, (Act No 10 of 1972,), ("the Offences Act") and the Convention on the International Recognition of Rights in Aircraft Act, 1993, (Act No 59 of 1993), ("Rights in Aircraft Act"). Therefore, the Civil Aviation Regulations, 1997, ("the CAR"), as well as the Chapters of the Air Navigation Regulations, 1976, and the Chapters of the Rules of the Air, Air Traffic Services, Search and Rescue and Overflight Regulations, 1975, (promulgated in terms of section 22(1) of the Aviation Act, 1962), which are in force in terms of regulation 183.00.4(4) and (5) of the CAR, are administered by the Authority. Furthermore, the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations, 1981, promulgated in terms of section 2L of the Offences Act, and the Mortgaging of Aircraft Regulations, 1997, promulgated in terms of section 14 of the Rights in Aircraft Act are also administered by the Authority.*
3. *The South African Civil Aviation Authority Levies Act, 1998 (Act No 41 of 1998), makes provision for the imposition of levies by the Authority.*
4. *The Statutes and Regulations referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3 above are applicable to the aviation industry and the relevant industry players are regulated by the Authority in terms thereof.*
