GENERAL NOTICE ISSUED BY THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION WITH REFERENCE TO AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULARS PUBLISHED IN TERMS OF THE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS 1997

1. DETAILS OF NOTICE

The implementation of SA CAR 2011 on 01 August 2012 has resulted in the incorrect references to the Aeronautical Information Circulars issued in terms of CAR 1997.

The AIC issued in terms of CAR 1997 are however still valid due to the Saving Clause of SA CAR 2011, Regulation 188.00.2 (1) which reads as follows:

188.00.2 (1) Subject to these Regulations, any license, authorization, registration, certificate, permission, approval, decision, exemption, direction, order, suspension, determination or condition issued, given, granted made or imposed under any provision of the Regulation repealed by regulation 188.00.1, and any other act or thing performed, done or omitted under such a provision is regarded as having been issued, given, granted, made, imposed, done or omitted under the corresponding provision of these Regulations.

This notice is issued to inform the public that all Aeronautical Information Circulars issued in terms of CAR 1997, are still valid and should be construed to refer to the corresponding provision of the CAR 2011. For example, a reference in an AIC to Regulation 61.13.1 (For the Requirements of Class and Type Ratings) should be construed as a reference to Regulation 61.09.1, which is a corresponding provision.

2. PERIOD OF NOTICE

This notice will be in force for 12 months starting from 01 August 2012.
