BARBERTON AIRFIELD (FABR) SAFETY WARNING

- ☛ Indicate changes
- ☛ This AIC replaces AIC 21-2 dated 09 February 2012.
- 1. Approved parachuting drop zone overhead airfield 7000 FT ALT up to FL120 with Air Traffic Control (ATC) clearance.
- 2. Airfield is used as a Filming Location.
- ☛ 3. Low level aircraft operations including stunt flying and aerobatics takes place within 5nm radius of the airfield and often communicate on private frequencies so as not to congest frequency 130.35 MHz.
- 4. Occasional use of Explosives / Pyrotechnics and High Power Lasers for Special Effects Purposes for Stunts, Film & TV productions as well as Aerial Pyrotechnics.
- 5. The above activities can take place any time day or night.
- 6. SAPS approved explosives blast sites, aerial pyrotechnic launch sites and explosives magazines are located on the airfield.
- ☛ 7. Pilots are requested to call or announce their intentions on frequency 130.35 MHz within a 5nm radius if intending to land, operate in the vicinity of or overhead Barberton Airfield.
