**OPERATION OF AIRCRAFT  
REGULATION**

**MICROLIGHT FLYING IN ZIMBABWE**

1. *In terms of Regulation 2.24A(c) of the Air Navigation Regulations, 1976 a microlight pilot is entitled to act "as pilot in command of a microlight aeroplane on an International flight: Provided that prior approval for such flight shall have been obtained in writing from the aviation authority of the country to be entered". The LSI category, "Authority to fly" issued for microlights also contains a condition that this category of aircraft may not be operated over a foreign country without special permission from the aviation authority of that country. It should also be noted that such flights may not be undertaken by the pilot for remuneration.*
2. *Accordingly any pilot wishing to undertake a flight to Zimbabwe must contact the Zimbabwe Microlight Aircraft Association (ZMAA) for approval and procedures to be followed whilst operating in their country.*
