Windsock: Yes.

Landing suggestion: Flying to and from Satara Airstrip must follow a defined corridor as prescribed. Under normal conditions, landings must be on Runway 19 and take-off on Runway 01.

Arrival: From entry into KNP approach via: - SATA A positioned along the Acornhoek / Orpen tar road at the northern entrance gate to Manyeleti GR, outside the KNP - proceed to SATA B at Nwamutsatsa waterhole - from SATA B proceed to SATA C, positioned at the point where the flight corridor crosses the Orpen / Satara tar road. This point is +/- 3 km east of where the S36 and the S39 tourist dirt roads join the tar road at co-ordinates S 24 o 22' 52.2 ; E 031 o 39' 10.8. - thereafter, proceed to SATA D positioned near Witpens drinking trough just west of the Satara / Letaba tar road - proceed to SATA E positioned just east of SATA D and the Satara / Letaba tar road and the point from where aircraft flying into Satara will line up for final approach and landing on Runway 19 (from the north). This is the approved approach unless adverse weather (wind) prevents such landing where-upon aircraft will do a circular approach and land on Runway 01 from the south according to prescribed procedures, - SATA E and onto final approach for Runway 19. Please refer to appendix 2 for map of the prescribed flight corridor.

Take off suggestion: Flights from Satara Airstrip must follow the same route for landing in reverse. - Aircraft must execute an early left hand turn out after take-off; - Do not cross the tar road during climb out; - Continue with a climbing turn and proceed via SATA E, D, C, B and A as per altitude instruction;

Approved aircraft types that cannot comply with this procedure shall not be permitted to fly the charter in the prevailing conditions. Buildings: Satara Airstrip Receiving area Satara Airstrip Hanger
