RE: DECISION IN RESPECT OF APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION

1. Your exemption application dated 21 March 2023, refers.
2. The exemption application is submitted in terms of section 130 (4) of the Civil Aviation Act, 2009 (Act No. 13 of 2009) (the Act) read with Regulation 11, Subpart 4 of the Civil Aviation Regulations, 2011 (CARs), in terms of which you have requested the aviation industry to be exempted from compliance with the provisions of **Part 92.01.47 together with SA-CATS 92.01.47, Part 92.02.1 – 2 and CATS 92.02.1; 2A; 2B, as well as Part 92.04.1 – 2 and CATS 92.04.1A; 1B & 1C**, for a period of **180 days**.
3. Your application was considered, and the Director has made her decision in respect of your exemption application.
4. In line with the authorisation granted by the Director to the signatory of this letter, this letter serves to convey the decision of the Director on your exemption application.
5. Kindly be advised that your exemption application is hereby **granted**, and the aviation industry is exempted from compliance with the provisions of **Part 92.01.47 together with SA-CATS 92.01.47, Part 92.02.1 – 2 together with CATS 92.02.1; 2A; 2B, as well as Part 92.04.1 – 2 and CATS 92.04.1A; 1B & 1C**, for a period of **180 days**, subject to the following conditions:

- 5.1. All dangerous goods procedure manuals and dangerous goods training programmes shall be submitted to the SACAA within 180 days from date of issue of this letter;
 - 5.2. All applications to handle dangerous goods shall be submitted to the SACAA within 180 days from date of issue of this letter;
 - 5.3. All applications for dangerous goods instructor accreditation shall be submitted to the SACAA within 180 days from date of issue of this letter; and
 - 5.4. The SACAA to continue to conduct inspections to verify industry compliance with the regulations.
6. The Director reserves the right to revoke and/or suspend this approval should it deem it necessary to do so, in the interest of aviation safety and/or security.
 7. We thank you for your application and you are requested to ensure that the conditions imposed upon you are complied with.
