Requirements Relating to the practical assessment of candidates for the issuance of a PARTAC approval.

1. Purpose

To extend the existing privileges of Air Traffic Services DE's (Aerodrome Rated) appointed from November 2019 to September 2020, to include the competency assessment, in their use of RTF phraseology and aviation English, for persons driving on the airside under the **Practical Airport Radio Telephony and Airside Competency (PARTAC)** requirements at their appointed airfield for a period of 12 months (October 2021).

2. Discussion

The ATS DE's (aerodrome rated) are ideally suited to conduct a radio competency assessment on airside drivers, as this is a natural extension of their existing DE functions, whereby they must assess and sign out ATC's to, amongst others, be able to use the radio to communicate with pilots. The radio competency required from an airside driver is less than what is required from pilots or ATC's, as the scope of communication is limited to just ground traffic movements.
