- 2. The Operator is to ensure that all members of the staff are familiar with such procedures as set out herein that relates to the maintenance of aircraft are followed at all times.
- The Operator is also to ensure that in exercising the privilege of Approved Programme number J15/9/____ and the provisions of the South African Civil Aviation Regulations 2011, as amended, are complied with at all times.
- 4. The Operator may only vary the periods prescribed by the programme with the approval of the CAA or through a procedure developed in the maintenance programme and approved by the CAA.
- 5. The approved maintenance programme should be subject to periodic review or at least annually to ensure continued validity and that it reflect the current TC holder's recommendations, revisions to the MRB report or Chapter 5 of the maintenance manual if applicable, mandatory requirements and the maintenance needs of the aircraft in the light of operating experience.
- 6. No amendments shall be made to this Aircraft Maintenance Programme without the written approval of the Director of Civil Aviation. When approved (by means of a signature on the list of effective pages), such amendments shall be incorporated and implemented immediately.
