When the Tee handle is pulled out to the max limit it fouls with the control column in extreme forward right/left position. This combination of control positions is considered very rare. Therefore risk factor is very low.

2. Provide the number and description of occurrences that prompted the mandatory service bulletin:

During ground inspection of XL206 Company Pilot observed the Hazard as stated above and suggested to relocate the Tee handle.

3. How was the compliance time(s) established?

This combination of control positions/Tee handle full on is considered very rare therefore Compliance at next 150 hour check in accordance with the PASB/XL/093 is acceptable.

Installation man hours = 2 hours
