
**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO WITHDRAW AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR –
AIC 18.28**

SOUTH AFRICAN CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY

- (a) Notice is hereby given to the members of the aviation industry, that the South African Civil Aviation Authority intends to withdraw Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) 18.28.
- (b) The content of AIC 18.28 relates to commercial aircraft operations under Part 121, 127 and 135 of the Technical Standards issued under the Civil Aviation Regulations, 2011, specifically the requirement to put in place the Quality Control System in the operations manual.
- (c) The Content of AIC 18.28 has been superseded by the promulgated amendment to Document SA-CATS 121 and Document SA-CATS 135 which contain the Requirements for the Quality Management System in Technical Standards 121.10.08 and 135.10.08 respectively. The amendment to Document SA-CATS 127 to specify the Requirements for the Quality Management System is imminent.
- (d) Parties who believe their rights may be adversely affected by the withdrawal of AIC 18.28 may submit written comments indicating how such rights will be affected by the withdrawal on or before **30 September 2026**.
