## 1. AMENDMENT OF DOCUMENT SA-CATS 121

- (a) Document SA-CATS 121 is hereby amended by the substitution in Technical Standard 121.07.13 for section 6 subsection (3) of the following subsection:
  - "(3) (a) With effect from 1 January 2025, an aeroplane of a MCM of over 27000 kg for which the individual certificate of airworthiness was first issued on or after 1 January 2024, shall autonomously transmit information from which a position can be determined by an air service operator at least once every minute, when in distress.
  - (b) An aeroplane of a MCM of over 5700 kg up to 27000 kg for which the individual certificate of airworthiness was first issued on or after 1 January 2023, shall autonomously transmit information from which a position can be determined by an air service operator at least once every minute, when in distress"."
