

PROPOSAL FOR THE AMENDMENT OF DOCUMENT SA-CATS 64 ISSUED UNDER THE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS, 2011

PROPOSER

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PROPOSER'S INTEREST

The proposer has been established in terms of the Civil Aviation Act, 2009 (Act No. 13 of 2009), to control and regulate civil aviation in South Africa and to oversee the functioning and development of the civil aviation industry, and, in particular, to control, regulate and promote civil aviation safety and security.

PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENT OF DOCUMENT SA-CATS 64

1.1 It is hereby proposed to amend Document SA-CATS 64 by the substitution for Regulation 64.02.5 of the following regulation:

"64.02.5 APPLICATION FOR CABIN CREW MEMBER LICENCE

1. Skill test report

(a) **[The]** A skill test report that shall accompany an application for the **[issuing]** issuance of a student cabin crew member licence or for the updating of a cabin crew member licence competency and validity is contained in the appropriate form on the Authority website.

- (b) **[The] A** skill test report that shall accompany an application for the **[issuing of a cabin crew member licence is]** maintenance or revalidation of competency, aircraft type rating, or validation of a foreign licence and rating or competency card is contained in the appropriate form on the Authority website.”.

MOTIVATION

The Technical Standards erroneously refer to the skills test report for a cabin crew member licence. Additionally, there is no reference informing the industry where to find skills test report forms that must be submitted to the Authority for licence endorsement.
