The pilot of ZS-XAS reported that when they were abeam Rustenburg, the weather became bad with low clouds. He made an attempt to contact ZS-XAT but was unsuccessful and he elected to return to FALA. A witness reported that he partially saw the aircraft flying low in clouds and coming from the direction of Rustenburg. He saw the aircraft making two right turns and it sounded as if it was at high speed, 30 seconds later he heard a loud bang and he rushed to the direction where he found other workers and they called the EMS. The helicopter settled in an upright position before the engine stopped. The pilot secured the helicopter.
