Maintenance of Competency lapsed by more than 36 months from date of last revalidation check. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rewrite the Air Law and Procedures or Air Law examination, as applicable at an approved South African Civil Aviation Examination Centre. • Undergo sufficient ground and flight training at an approved ATO to reach the standard required for the revalidation check of a PPL(A) and meet the recency requirements to act as PIC. • Pass an initial license skills test in the same category of aircraft
