1.	Applicant 17 years or older	
2.	Valid Class 1 or Class 2 medical certificate issued in terms of Part 67	
3.	Restricted or general radiotelephony certificate	
4.	Completed and signed relevant application form	
5.	Show evidence of holding a valid Student Pilot Licence or having held, within the previous 60 months, any of the following - (i) a pilot licence (aeroplane) issued by a Contracting State; or (ii) a Recreational Pilot Licence issued in terms of Part 62	
6.	Have successfully completed the training as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61 at an approved Part 141 aviation training organisation	
7.	Passed all 8 (eight) subjects within 18 months calculated from the date of the first pass and must have passed the final theoretical knowledge examination within the 36 months preceding the skills test for a PPL (Helicopter)	
8.	A minimum of 50 hours total flight time	
9.	Minimum of 25 hours dual instruction	
10.	Minimum of 15 hours SOLO	
11.	Minimum of 5 hours SOLO Cross Country may be included in the 15-hour SOLO requirement	
12.	Logbook copies, including career summary and endorsement of skills test by Instructor/DE on the logbook	
13.	Outcome of test to be marked on skills test	
14.	Sign next to all amendments and no tippex allowed	
15.	Appropriately valid rated Instructor / DFE checked	
16.	The appropriate fee as prescribed in Part 187	
17.	Show proof of English Language Proficiency in terms of CAR 61.01.7
