ISSUE: CAR 61.11. (Skill test form must be submitted within 30 days of the skills test)		
1.	Hold a valid Student Pilot Licence if a student on an integrated course or hold a valid Pilot Licence	
2.	Hold a night rating	
3.	Signed and completed relevant application form	
4.	Hold a valid Class 1 or 2 medical certificate	
5.	Have passed the theoretical knowledge examinations as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61	
6.	Outcome of test to be marked on skills test	
7.	Have successfully completed the training as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61 at an approved Part 141 aviation training organisation	
8.	Have undergone the skills test referred to in regulation 61.11.4 within 36 months of passing the examinations referred to in (4) above and within 30 days of the last period of dual instruction	
9	Logbook copies including career summary and endorsement of skills test by Instructor/DE on the logbook	
10.	Have a valid general certificate of proficiency in radio telephony	
11.	Sign next to all amendments and no tippex allowed	
12.	Skills test initialed on each page by the DFE and applicant	
13.	Have 50 hours cross country flying as PIC (10 hours shall be in the category for which an instrument rating is sought)	
14.	Have 10 hours dual instrument flight training (5 hours may be in an approved FSTD)	
15.	If a multi-engine instrument rating is sought, then 5 hours dual instrument flight training is required on the aircraft type used in the skills test	
16.	If the applicant already holds an instrument rating, and an instrument rating is required in a different category of aircraft, then 5 hours dual instrument flight training in the new category (3 of the required 5 hours may be in an approved FSTD for the category of aircraft).	
17.	Appropriately valid rated DFE checked	
18.	The appropriate fee as prescribed in Part 187
