1.	Hold a valid Commercial Pilots (A) or Airline Transport Pilots Licence (A)	
2.	Signed and completed relevant application form	
3.	Have completed 20 hours of flight instructor patten (Minimum of 15 hours in an aircraft and 5 hours may be in a FSTD) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 hours patten training if the applicant is the holder of a flight instructor rating in another category of aircraft 	
4.	Have passed the theoretical knowledge examinations as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Principles of flight (A) only if a flight instructor rating is held in another category of aircraft 	
5.	Have successfully completed the training as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61 at an approved Part 141 aviation training organisation	
6.	Have undergone the skills test referred to in regulation 61.12.4 within 36 months of passing the examinations referred to in (4) above and within 30 days of the last period of dual instruction	
7.	Skills test conducted in an aircraft with a MCM in excess of 450 kg or a Level D FSTD	
8.	Logbook copies, including endorsement of skills test by Instructor/DE on the logbook	
9.	Sign next to all amendments and no tippex allowed	
10.	Skills test to be initialed on each page by the instructor/DFE and applicant.	
11.	Show proof of English Language Proficiency in terms of CAR 61.01.7	
12.	Appropriately valid rated DFE checked	
13.	The appropriate fee as prescribed in Part 187
