1.	Hold a valid Commercial Pilots (A) or Airline Transport Pilots Licence (A)	
2.	Hold a valid Instrument Rating	
3.	Hold or have held a Grade II Instructors Rating not expired for more than 90 days.	
4.	Signed and completed relevant application form	
5.	Outcome of test to be marked on skills test	
6.	Have given 1500 hours of flight instruction as a flight instructor (A)	
7.	Have acquired 10 hours of instrument flight training in aircraft or in an approved FSTD in the six months preceding application	
8.	Have successfully completed the training as prescribed in Document SA-CATS 61 at an approved Part 141 aviation training organisation	
9.	Have undergone the skills test referred to in regulation 61.14.4 within 30 days of application	
10.	Skills test initialed on each page by DFE and applicant	
11.	Logbook copies, including endorsement of skills test by Instructor/DE on the logbook	
12.	Sign next to all amendments and no tippex allowed	
13.	Skills test conducted in; - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a complex single or multi-engine aeroplane with retractable undercarriage and variable pitch propeller; or • in an aircraft with a turbojet engine; or • in an approved level D FSTD. 	
14.	Appropriately valid rated DFE checked	
15.	The appropriate fee as prescribed in Part 187
